Attributes of A Successful Online Learner

- ◆ You have to have a sense of self. Successful learners online have an awareness of self-motivation, self-starting, and ownership of one's actions. In other words, they reflect on how they learn as well as what they learn.
- ◆ You need to be able to manage your time wisely. You must be able to lay out your tasks with a critical eye, plan them accordingly, and follow them through to fruition—many times without someone looking over your shoulder.
- ◆ You have GOT to know how to collaborate. This is critical. More than an understanding of technology, more than a perfection of writing skills, the ability to collaborate is one that must be used comfortably online.
- ◆ You need to be able to set goals for yourself. Being able to see the target and backwards planning towards that target is vital.
- ◆ You need to communicate well in writing. The entire online community is based on the language of words and how to communicate them effectively. One cannot use texting language and expect to be heard. A student needs to use their best level of writing.
- ◆ You must follow the community norms. Just like a face-to-face classroom has a set of rules, so does an online class. A student must function within the norms and rules of netiquette set up by the instructor, or better yet, agreed upon by the class itself.
